**This plan is eligible for Rollover Maximum:** Rollover Max dollars do not apply to orthodontic services. To qualify for Rollover Max, you must receive at least one cleaning or oral exam in the plan year. You must be enrolled for dental coverage before the 4<sup>th</sup> quarter of the plan year (10/1-12/31) and your paid claims must not exceed the maximum "threshold" amount.

<sup>2</sup> Ask your dentist to submit a pre-treatment estimate to Delta Dental for any procedure that exceeds \$300. This will help you estimate in advance any out-of-pocket expenses you may incur.

<sup>3</sup> An endosteal implant (a device surgically inserted into the bone to provide support for a single restoration) when used in lieu of a three unit bridge and the adjacent abutment teeth are healthy and do not need restorations. For example, if an adjacent abutment tooth has or requires a crown then the member would be eligible for the bridge benefit and not the implant.
