Each of the programs welcomes and encourages parent participation. Child-centered, play-based and developmentally focused, CCC programs look to a variety of educational philosophies to guide their work.</p>	<p>Schedules and Calendars Regular hours are 8am to 6pm. Annual calendars vary slightly from one center to another and are generally posted on individual websites. Most enrollment is for full-time full-week spaces. PTCC and WACC offer limited part-week and part-time enrollments.</p>
