Summary

Performs a variety of duties related to the care and feeding of laboratory animals and the maintenance of the animal facilities.

Typical Duties

- 1. Feeds and cares for laboratory animals.
- 2. Assigns tasks to Animal Technician I and II and may assist in their training.
- 3. Maintains animal facilities area.
- 4. Prepares special food.
- 5. Weighs and takes temperature of animals.
- 6. Reports and records activities and any deviation from the norm pertaining to the animals.
- 7. Maintains animal care/facility records.
- 8. May administer special care to animals for investigators.
- 9. Performs related job duties as required.

Typical Requirements

Education: American Association of Laboratory Animal Science certificate as animal technician preferred.

Skills and Experience: Three or more years of experience in animal care or equivalent.
