

Health Care Job Function

Nurse's Assistant Grade 48

Summary

Assists with the personal care and routine treatment of patients under the supervision of the professional nursing staff.

Education: High school graduate or equivalent. Skills and Experience: One year of experience as a nurse's assistant preferred.

Typical Duties

- 1. Provides a wide range of personal care services for assigned patients, such as making beds, giving baths, and assisting in moving and lifting patients.
- 2. Performs various assigned treatments such as enemas, hot packs, and throat irrigations.
- 3. Measures and records vital signs.
- 4. Assists with the application of comfort devices and safety measures.
- 5. Transports patients to and from various locations within the Health Service facility.
- 6. Performs messenger duties.
- 7. Maintains and requisitions medical supplies.
- 8. Maintains cleanliness of medical equipment used in direct patient care.
- 9. Performs related job duties as required.

Typical Requirements

Education: High school graduate or equivalent.

Skills and Experience: One year of experience as a nurse's assistant preferred.
