Summary

Performs radiographic procedures by the application of ionizing radiation or other diagnostic methods to produce radiographs.

Typical Duties

- 1. Selects proper technical factors for each patient, adjusting equipment accordingly.
- 2. Operates equipment providing protection in accordance with prescribed safety standards.
- 3. Develops film through use of automatic or manual equipment.
- 4. Assists physicians in administering contrast material.
- 5. Maintains records of patients and films.
- 6. May type and file reports and films.
- 7. Performs related job duties as required.

Typical Requirements

Education: Completion of formal program beyond high school. Certification by the American Registry of Radiologic Technology required.

Skills and Experience: No previous experience required.
