# Radiologic Technician

Grade 51

### Summary

Performs radiographic procedures by the application of ionizing radiation or other diagnostic methods to produce radiographs.

### Typical Duties

1. Selects proper technical factors for each patient, adjusting equipment accordingly.
2. Operates equipment providing protection in accordance with prescribed safety standards.
3. Develops film through use of automatic or manual equipment.
4. Assists physicians in administering contrast material.
5. Maintains records of patients and films.
6. May type and file reports and films.
7. Performs related job duties as required.

### Typical Requirements

*Education:* Completion of formal program beyond high school. Certification by the American Registry of Radiologic Technology required.

*Skills and Experience:* No previous experience required.
